School Portal

The School Portal is the school's main and beneficial source of communication between parents and the school. Parents get to review more holistic information on their child's education in Seven Skies i.e., timetable, attendance and the school reports.

As it is a one-stop information centre, all of the information that we send out via email are found on the portal too, as we aim to ensure the information reaches everyone. Newsletters and announcements are uploaded onto this portal. We will continue to mass mail notices and post them on your children's official school Telegram channels too.

Parents can locate their children's official progress term reports on this portal too. It is, therefore, extremely vital that parents access the School Portal regularly to get up-to-date information.


All parents, especially the new ones, are to take note of the following:

- Parents will be able to access the Parent Portal through the school website using their child(ren)'s login details.
- Parents can change their portal login ID to their preferred ID, using a valid e-mail address provided to the school.

We hope that you find the school portal user-friendly and informative. The 2024/2025 academic calendar is also on the portal. It is important to refer to the updated school calendar here. It is refreshed as and when we receive instructions or information from MOE.

Main Communication Channel- Telegram

SSIS uses Telegram for broadcasting news feed and updates to parents for immediate alerts and updates. One Telegram account is created and dedicated for each class, and managed by the school. Relevant information and announcements will be shared via these Telegram accounts.



To join a child's class Telegram account, a parent is required to email the Admin Department (admin@sevenskies.edu.my) and copy the Admissions Department (admissions@sevenskies.edu.my) the following information:

Please rest assured that these channels will be on anonymous mode to help admins keep everyone safe from unnecessary updates, comments and personal attacks. Parents also need not worry as all profiles will be hidden and only the admins can send direct messages. The school will also ensure there will be no spam or unnecessary messages.

School Hours



Monday - Friday

Kindergarten : 8:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Grade 1 – 11 : 8:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.

All students are required to reach school 15 minutes before the start of each instructional day. They are to attend fifteen-minute contact time slots with their respective class and/or assistant teachers. These slots will be used to develop bonds with the students, set high expectations and enforce classroom rules.

Activities include conducting attendance registration, disseminating important information for the day and building rapport. This makes the classroom become a place where every student feels wanted, appreciated and loved. This type of atmosphere eventually builds sustaining self-confidence for the students too.

School Assemblies

Please take note that attendance to weekly school assemblies is compulsory. Scheduled into the school timetable, they are conducted on Wednesdays, 8:00 a.m. to 8:50 a.m.

We understand that students are probably feeling a little anxious, especially the new and younger ones. Therefore, we will be having a special one-hour 'Welcome Back' Assembly for all students on Monday, 2 September to help all students ease back into school for the new academic year.

There will also be opportunities to ask questions at the session and be given specific guidelines and feedback to ease their transition. Students can refer to their own class teachers for further clarification on school matters too.

Please be strongly advised that any absences will directly affect a student's school leaving certificate.





Curbing Tardiness

Thank you all for making sure your child attends school every day and is here on time.

Remember that contact time, which is held from 7:45 a.m. to 8:00 a.m., is part of the school's instructional day, and it is a student's responsibility to be present for the whole school day.

If a student is tardy to school, he/she is missing contact time, a time when important announcements are made, information is disseminated and advisory connections are established.

Late children must check in their attendance at the main administrative office upon arrival. It is an indication that the child is present to school but late for class. Personnel from the admin office will record this onto the online registration platform.

The subject teachers will then pick this up when they do their period-to-period attendance. All lateness will also be reflected in the child's "Session Attendance" in the school portal.

A first reminder will be sent by the Discipline Department to notify parents if tardiness happens three times in a calendar month. Parents of latecomers will receive a second email if tardiness continues.

The school will then schedule a meeting with the parent of the student if punctuality to school is still of concern, despite the first two reminders. At that time, the school will determine whether all of the tardiness is excusable or if detention should be assigned.

A student will also unfortunately be given demerit points for the third tardy case in a calendar month.

This policy will continue to serve as a guideline on how the school assigns demerit points, and after-school classes. **To avoid tardiness, drop your children off latest by 7:45 a.m. on school days**.

School Uniform & Sportswear

Every student should have the correct school wear for his/her return to school, on 2 September 2024.

In view of that, kindly ensure that all items of uniform and sportswear purchased are consistent with all school requirements.

- All students should be in full school uniform, every Monday and Friday.
- Students must wear black socks and appropriate school shoes, preferably black canvas shoes.
- All students should be correctly attired in either P.E. or house t-shirts and plain navy blue/black track bottoms for P.E. and ECA activities.
- Track bottoms should preferably not have stripes, patterns or logos on them.
 Tights and leggings are not allowed for P.E. and CCA.
- The Seven Skies varsity jacket is the official school jacket and should be worn. Alternatively, a plain black jacket is also allowed.

Therefore, it is imperative that every member of our school community strictly adheres to the school traffic policy. Disregarding these guidelines not only undermines our collective responsibility but also puts the lives of our children at serious risk. 
ssis hopes that parents are united with the school in implementing them to prevent any untoward incident. This will require full understanding and compliance to the security policies/measures the school is implementing.

Please arrange a suitable time to drop off your child, latest by 7:45 a.m. in time for your child's daily contact time. Pick-ups are to be done between 3:30 p.m. and 4:30 p.m.

SSIS practises the "Drive Through Only" policy to help reduce traffic congestion. Kindly observe all school traffic rules and the instructions given by the security personnel whilst on school compound.

In an effort to improve the efficiency of traffic management, the school implements a Dashboard Card System as shown below. Picture 1 shows a Dashboard Card with just a student's name whilst Picture 2 shows the names of two students (siblings) to be picked up.

Your due diligence in following the directions of the school guards will assist in improving the school's traffic flow. It is our hope that this will speed up pick-up times.


Please help us reduce congestion too by saying your goodbyes to your child/ren at home and/or in the car on the way to school.

The map depicted on the right is a simple summary of the traffic flow for pick-ups and drop-offs. Our security team and teachers will be on duty to quicken the pick-up process.

We would appreciate your cooperation should they ask you to move your vehicle. Please avoid drama. They are just performing the duties discharged to them.

To lower the risk of any untoward incidents, parents are not allowed to be in school during school hours and pick-up times. Only those on official matters are allowed to come into the school. Parents are to conclude the necessary tasks at the main administrative office and quickly leave.

Your child must be constantly reminded of his/her own responsibility on safety too. Please follow the rules and procedures to keep everyone safe! I truly appreciate your support with this. Thank you!




Looking Ahead
